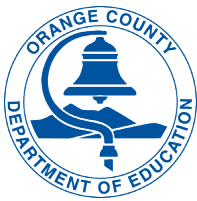

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Stipend Incentives are available to all Title V Center Based (CTTR)/State Preschool (CSPP) program teachers/aides and Family Child Care and Home Education Network (FCCHEN) providers.
2. Work directly with children in classroom as an assistant/aide or teacher; birth -11 years; must not be a floater, substitute teacher or non-paid Intern (Not applicable for PGA's).
3. Full-time employees of Early Head Start, Head Start, Even Start or Children and Families Commission program are not eligible.
4. All stipend incentive amounts are dependent upon program eligibility requirements, priorities, funding availability, and may be subject to change.
5. All requirements must be completed and uploaded to the QSOC iPinwheel QRIS Management System by required due dates. Staff of Agencies not participating in QRIS must submit all required documentation as requested by OCDE EECIP.

**** Applicants earning 3 to 11 units will be given second priority for the stipend incentive; amounts will be determined based upon funding availability and by the OC LPC.***

*****All coursework must be taken at a regionally accredited college or university and be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. Coursework completed with a grade of Credit (C)/No-Credit (NCR)/Pass (P)/No-Pass (NP) are not acceptable.***

The Orange County EECIP provides professional growth, support and financial incentives for employees of the California Department of Education (CDE), Early Education and Support Division (EESD) subsidized child care centers and the Family Child Care and Home Education Network (FCCHEN) that are located in Orange County.
